**Councilman Heyward Livingston motioned that the minutes for the committee meeting on**

### **1. DISCUSSION OF CANEBRAKE COURT, OC-3377**

Chairman Ravenell recognized Deputy County Administrator Sinkler Boone. Administrator Boone advised that Public Services has received a request from a homeowners association in regards to Canebrake Court.
