1. Discussion of An Ordinance Amending Chapter 34 of the Orangeburg County Code of Ordinances Regarding Solid Waste, Including Violations, Penalties, and Other Related Matters

After a long discussion, Chairman Ravenell asked for a motion. Councilman Harry Wimberly made the motion to table the discussion of an ordinance amending Chapter 34 until another meeting. Councilman Heyward Livingston second the motion. Motion carried. (3-0-0)

2. Discussion of Loggers Traveling on Paved County Roads

After a long discussion about working with Crad Jaynes with the SC Timber Producers Association and Cam Crawford, Forestry Association of South Carolina to come up with a solution concerning the loggers damaging county-maintain roads. Chairman Ravenell asked for a motion. Councilman Heyward Livingston made the motion to table the discussion of an ordinance establishing a system for recouping costs incurred to repair damage to county-maintained roads for six months, also the Public Works Committee members will set up a meeting with the Forestry Association of South Carolina and the SC Timber Producers Association to set up some guidelines in order to avoid an ordinance and bring those guidelines back before Council. Councilman Harry Wimberly second the motion. Motion carried. (3-0-0)
