

Addendum

Invitation for Bid – Road Construction Project FY10-0105

Addendum No. 1 (herein referred to as “Addendum”)

This Addendum revises the above-described procurement, and is hereby incorporated and made a part of the above-described procurement as if the Addendum had been included in the original procurement documents. Addendum posted on website at www.orangeburgcounty.org-Purchasing/Bids-Solicitations

The addendum is as follows: Question and Clarification of Bid Security

Q. Will a Bid Bond be required?

A. Section 6-203 of Orangeburg County Codes states:

Bid Security. Requirement. Bid security shall be required for all methods of selection for construction contracts when the Director (Procurement Director) estimates the price to exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000). Bid security shall be a bond provided by a surety company authorized to do business in this State, or the equivalent in cash, or otherwise supplied in a form satisfactory to the Director. Bid security shall be in an amount equal to at least five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid and will remain in place until the latter of the following two occurrences: execution of the construction contract or posting of performance/payment bonds.

Vendor must submit a completed Addendum Acknowledgement form with its submission. Vendor may be disqualified from this procurement unless vendor submits a completed Addendum acknowledgment form referring to this addendum with vendor’s bid.
